

CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
Webster City, Iowa March 29, 2010

The City Council met in a regular council-utility session at the City Hall, Webster City, Iowa, at 7:00 p.m. March 29, 2010 upon call of the Mayor and the advance agenda. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Janet Adams and roll being called there were present Janet Adams, Mayor in the chair and the following named Council Members: Linda Conaway, Doug Getter, Jerry Kloberdanz and Geary Meyer.

It was moved by Getter and seconded by Kloberdanz to approve the agenda.

ROLL CALL: Adams, Conaway, Getter, Kloberdanz and Meyer voting aye.

PETITIONS – COMMUNICATIONS – REQUESTS

Mayor Adams asked City Manager Ed Sadler to speak to how the city clerk position was being handled, following the resignation of Justin Moore.

Sadler advised the various portions of the job are divided up among current employees, which will continue until a new clerk is hired.

Mayor and Mayor pro tem will go through the applications received to date.

GENERAL

1. It was moved by Kloberdanz and seconded by Conaway to concur in the appointment by the City Manager of Brian Hughes for Police Chief

ROLL CALL: Conaway, Getter, Kloberdanz, Meyer and Adams voting aye.

City Manager Ed Sadler outlined for the council the process followed in hiring the police chief. The new chief will begin on May 3, 2010.

2. It was moved by Getter and seconded by Meyer that Resolution No. 2010-035 establishing depositories for the City of Webster City and financial institutions, the maximum amount, which may be kept on deposit in each depository and designating authorized officers, be passed and adopted.

ROLL CALL: Getter, Kloberdanz, Meyer, Adams and Conaway voting aye.

CLOSED SESSION

It was moved by Conaway and seconded by Getter that the Council meet in closed session to discuss information relevant to the provision of electric service by the City Utility as per Iowa Code Chapters 21.5 a, 22.7 3 & 6, and 388.9 pertaining to confidential and competitive information in records

ROLL CALL: Kloberdanz, Meyer, Adams, Conaway and Getter voting aye.

The Council went into closed session at 7:08 p.m.
