

**City Council Meeting Minutes**  
**Webster City, Iowa October 14, 2008**

The City Council met in a special session at the City Hall, Webster City, Iowa, at 7:00 PM October 14, 2008 upon call of the Mayor and the advance agenda. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Eugene C. Gray and roll being called there were present Eugene C. Gray, Mayor and the following named Council Members: Janet Adams, Melissa Borer, Mark Gillette and Jerry Kloberdanz.

**APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA**

**GENERAL AGENDA**

City Manager Ed Sadler addressed the Council regarding a Flood Hazard Mitigation Grant Buyout program the City has the option of participating in.

The Council discussed a wide range of issues and concerns surrounding the program and the requirements to participate. Council also reviewed the number of responses to an initial letter to homeowners that was sent out in September.

The Council came to a **consensus** to send letters out to include vacant property owners and businesses within the 100 year flood plain in Webster City. In addition a letter will be sent again to homes within the 100 year flood plain, to determine any further interest in participating in the program. Council agreed to then meet again and determine interest in the program and thus make a determination on where the City will purchase properties.
