

**CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES**  
**November 4, 2010 Webster City, Iowa**

The City Council met in a special work session with Iowa Falls City Manager, Brian Weuve at City Hall, Webster City, Iowa, at 7:00 p.m. on November 4, 2010. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Janet Adams. Councilmembers present were Linda Conaway, Doug Getter, Jerry Kloberdanz and Geary Meyer.

Also present were City Manager Ed Sadler, City Clerk Karyl K. Bonjour and guest Iowa Falls City Manager Brian Weuve.

The Work Session was in regard to DNR (Department of Natural Resources) compliance and relating to infiltration issues at the wastewater plant.

Mayor Adams opened the meeting by introducing Brian to those in attendance. Mr. Weuve then presented information on the procedures Iowa Falls followed in bringing their city in compliance with their Sump Pump Ordinance. He provided copies of the Ordinance they have in place for the Webster City City Councilmembers to review.

Councilmembers were able to ask questions to clarify the procedures, penalties, outcome, and future plans Iowa Falls has in place in regard to their Sump Pump/Groundwater Standards.

City Manager Sadler informed Council that the First Reading of our Proposed Ordinance amending Chapter 97 of the Municipal Code on the Use of Public Sewers would be on the Agenda for November 15<sup>th</sup>. Any portion of the Ordinance that needs to be addressed/changed will need to be brought forward at that time.

Mayor Adams closed the work session.
