

CITY COUNCIL/AIRPORT COMMISSION JOINT WORK SESSION MEETING MINUTES
August 23, 2010 Webster City, Iowa

The City Council met in a special joint work session with the Airport Commission at City Hall, Webster City, Iowa, at 7:00 p.m. on August 23, 2010.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Janet Adams

Roll Call of City Council:

The Work Session of City Council and Airport Commission was a general discussion of Airport issues, current status and future plans for the Airport.
