

**CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES**  
**Webster City, Iowa April 3, 2006**

The City Council met in regular session at the City Hall, Webster City, Iowa, at 7:00 p. m. April 3, 2006 upon call of the Mayor and the advance agenda. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Eugene C. Gray and roll being called there were present Eugene C. Gray, Mayor in the chair and the following named Council Members: Janet Adams, Jack Foster, Mark Gillette, and Jerry Kloberdanz.

**APPR AGENDA**

It was moved by Foster and seconded by Adams to approve the Agenda.

It was moved by Kloberdanz and seconded by Foster that the following motions and resolutions are approved and adopted:
