

**CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES**  
**January 20, 2006 Webster City, Iowa**

The City Council met in special session at the City Hall, Webster City, Iowa, at 2:00 p.m. on January 20, 2006. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Eugene C. Gray, and roll being called there were present Eugene C. Gray, Mayor in the chair, and the following named Council Members: Janet Adams, Jack Foster, Mark Gillette and Jerry Kloberdanz.

It was moved by Gillette and seconded by Kloberdanz to approve the agenda.  
ROLL CALL: Foster, Gillette, Gray, Kloberdanz and Adams voting aye.

**MEETING PURPOSE: Budget Work Session**

It was moved by Adams and seconded by Kloberdanz that the social services agencies be funded as follows:

Community and Family Resources	\$5,000
Domestic/Sexual Assault Outreach Center	\$2,475
MIDAS Transit Systems-HaRides	\$9,500
Retired Senior Volunteer Program	\$2,000+ phone
Upper Des Moines Opportunity Inc.	\$6,000
Youth and Family Center of Hamilton County	\$5,000.

Kloberdanz withdrew his second to the motion; Adams withdrew her motion.

It was moved by Foster and seconded by Gillette that Community and Family Resources funding be zero.

ROLL CALL: Gillette and Foster voting aye.  
Gray, Kloberdanz and Adams voting nay.

THE MOTION FAILED

It was moved by Kloberdanz and seconded by Adams that Community and Family Resources be funded in the amount of \$3,000.00.

ROLL CALL: Gray, Kloberdanz and Adams voting aye.  
Foster and Gillette voting nay.

It was moved by Foster and seconded by Gillette that Domestic/Sexual Assault Outreach Center funding be zero.

ROLL CALL: Kloberdanz, Adams and Gray voting nay.  
Foster and Gillette voting aye.

THE MOTION FAILED

It was moved by Kloberdanz and seconded by Adams that Domestic/Sexual Assault Outreach Center be funded in the amount of \$1,800.00.

ROLL CALL: Adams and Kloberdanz voting aye.  
Foster, Gillette and Gray voting nay.

THE MOTION FAILED

It was moved by Gray and seconded by Adams that Domestic/Sexual Assault Outreach Center be funded in the amount of \$2,475.00.

ROLL CALL: Foster and Gillette voting nay.  
Gray, Kloberdanz and Adams voting aye.

It was moved by Gillette and seconded by Kloberdanz that MIDAS Transit Systems – HaRides be funded in the amount of \$9,500.00.

ROLL CALL: Gillette, Gray, Kloberdanz, Adams and Foster voting aye.

It was moved by Kloberdanz and seconded by Gillette that Retired Senior Volunteer Program be funded in the amount of \$2,000.00 plus no monthly charge of \$46.83.

ROLL CALL: Gray, Kloberdanz, Adams and Gillette voting aye.  
Foster voting nay.

It was moved by Gillette and seconded by Foster that Upper Des Moines Opportunity Inc. be funded in the amount of \$5,131.

ROLL CALL: Kloberdanz, Adams, Foster and Gillette voting aye.  
Gray voting nay.

It was moved by Foster and seconded by Gillette that Youth and Family Center of Hamilton County funding be zero.

ROLL CALL: Adams, Gray and Kloberdanz voting nay.  
Foster and Gillette voting aye.

THE MOTION FAILED

It was moved by Kloberdanz and seconded by Adams that Youth and Family Center of Hamilton County be funded in the amount of \$5,000.

ROLL CALL: Foster and Gillette voting nay.  
Gray, Kloberdanz and Adams voting aye.

It was moved by Foster and seconded by Gillette that the Airport Commission proposed budget be left at \$85,308.

ROLL CALL: Gillette, Gray, Kloberdanz, Adams and Foster voting aye.

It was moved by Foster and seconded by Gray to close and not winterize the Brewer Creek Shelter from October 15 to April 15 at a potential cost savings of \$2,536.03

ROLL CALL: Gray, Kloberdanz, Adams, Foster and Gillette voting aye.

It was moved by Adams and seconded by Kloberdanz that the Inspection Department Unsafe Building proposed budget and the Sidewalk Replacement-Assessed proposed budget each be reduced by \$5,000.

ROLL CALL: Kloberdanz, Adams and Foster voting aye.  
Gillette and Gray voting nay.

It was moved by Kloberdanz and seconded by Foster that the Electric Fund Tree Trimming proposed budget be reduced by \$10,000 and that amount be transferred to the General Fund.

ROLL CALL: Adams, Foster, Gillette, Gray and Kloberdanz voting aye.

It was moved by Adams and seconded by Foster to approve the Levy at Option 2 in the amount of \$15.99227 with the General Fund ending balance of 24 percent.

ROLL CALL: Foster, Gillette, Gray, Kloberdanz and Adams voting aye.

It was moved by Kloberdanz and seconded by Gillette that the Council adjourn.

ROLL CALL: Gillette, Gray, Kloberdanz, Adams and Foster voting aye.

The meeting was adjourned at 4:22 p.m.
