

CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
April 7, 2006 Webster City, Iowa

The City Council met in special session at the City Hall, Webster City, Iowa, at 12:45 p.m. April 7, 2006 upon call of the Mayor and the advance agenda. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Eugene C. Gray, and roll being called there were present Eugene C. Gray, Mayor in the chair, and the following named Council Members: Jack Foster, Mark Gillette and Jerry Kloberdanz. Janet Adams was absent.

It was moved by Foster and seconded by Kloberdanz to approve the agenda.
ROLL CALL: Foster, Gillette, Gray and Kloberdanz voting aye.

The Council interviewed Ed Sadler candidate for city manager.
Janet Adams arrived and answered roll call at 1:12 p.m.

It was moved by Foster and seconded by Gillette that the Council meet in closed session to evaluate the professional competency of the individuals whose appointment is being considered when necessary to prevent needless and irreparable injury to that individuals' reputation and that individual requests a closed session as provided by Section 21.5 of the Code of Iowa.

ROLL CALL: Foster, Gillette, Gray, Kloberdanz and Adams voting aye.
The Council went into closed session at 1:35 p.m.
The Council returned to open session at 2:08 p.m.

It was moved by Kloberdanz and seconded by Adams to authorize consultant Jim Brimeyer to negotiate a contract with the preferred candidate.

At 2:22 p.m. Mayor Gray called for a recess to obtain Assistant City Attorney Mark Hemmingson's opinion on a legal issue.

The Council returned from recess at 2:31 p.m.

After receiving the Assistant City Attorney's opinion, Kloberdanz and Adams revised their original motion as follows: to authorize consultant Jim Brimeyer to negotiate a contract with one or more candidates for city manager.

ROLL CALL: Kloberdanz, Adams, Foster, Gillette and Gray voting aye.

It was moved by Foster and seconded by Gillette that the Council adjourn.

ROLL CALL: Adams, Foster, Gillette, Gray and Kloberdanz voting aye.
The meeting was adjourned at 2:34 p.m.
