

CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
December 11, 2007 Webster City, Iowa

The City Council met in special session at the City Hall, Webster City, Iowa, at 4:15 p.m. December 11, 2007 upon call of the Mayor and the advance agenda. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Eugene C. Gray, and roll being called there were present Eugene C. Gray, Mayor in the chair, and the following named Council Members: Janet Adams, Jack Foster, Mark Gillette and Jerry Kloberdanz.

It was moved by Kloberdanz and seconded by Foster to approve the agenda.

The purpose of the meeting was a work session on future vision for Webster City concerning zoning.

Each Councilperson and the City Manager had prepared maps with their ideas for future zoning and then presented their views and concerns.

It was agreed that the City Manager give copies of all the maps with their visions highlighted to the City Planning and Zoning Commission so they could see what the Council's ideas were for the future of Webster City.

The Council discussed evaluations for appointed officials.
The City Manager will develop a draft form for the council to use in evaluating appointed officials.

The Council interviewed five candidates(Randy Chalfant, Eric Myers, Laric Elbert, Jean Fox and Pat Westcott) for the Hotel/Motel Tax Board. Appointments for this board will be made on January 7, 2008.

It was moved by Foster and seconded by Adams that the council adjourn.
