## CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES – WORK SESSION Webster City, Iowa May 9, 2017

The City Council met in a special Work Session at the City Hall, Webster City, Iowa at 6:00 p.m. on May 9, 2017, upon call of the Mayor and the advance agenda.

- 1. The meeting was called to order by Mayor John Hawkins and roll being called there were present John Hawkins, Mayor in the chair, and the following Council Members: Matt McKinney, Jim Talbot and Logan Welch.

- 4. The purpose of the Work Session was for JEO Consulting Group, Inc., of Norfolk, Nebraska to present preliminary findings on the Electric Rate Study requested by Council. The study was requested due to a rate increase being passed to our Utility from North Iowa Municipal Electric Company and Basin.
- Dave Peterson, representative of JEO Consulting Group, Inc., went through the preliminary study including past, current and future projections. Discussion was held on amending the current Ordinance with any changes that may be deemed necessary.
